Eye drops, emulsion



Read all of this leaflet carefully before you start using this product.

Keep this leaflet; you may need to read it again.

If you have any further questions, ask your doctor/ pharmacist/ optometrist. If symptoms persist, consult your doctor.

1. What is Cationorm® and what it is used for

Cationorm® is a positively charged emulsion designed to treat dry eyes. It comes in a milky liquid form.

Cationorm® hydrates, lubricates and protects the surface of the eye. It is intended for the treatment of dry eye symptoms such as stinging, itching or burning eyes, excessive watering or when it feels like there's something in your eye like sand or dust. These symptoms can come from air conditioning, pollution, flying, staring at screens, or wearing contact lenses. They can also be caused by certain medical conditions, eye procedures/ surgery and medications.

2. Before using Cationorm®

Do not use Cationorm® if you are allergic to any of the components of the product.

This product is not intended for the treatment of other eye conditions. Please consult your doctor, pharmacist or optometrist if you have any questions.

If you currently use other eye drops, you should wait at least 5 minutes between the administration of each successive eye drop. It is recommended to use Cationorm® last.

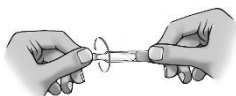
Cationorm® is compatible with all kinds of contact lenses.

3. How to use Cationorm®

USE IN THE EYE.

The recommended dose regimen is 1 drop in each eye, 1 to 4 times daily.

Instructions for use:



- Wash your hands.
- Take one single-dose container and shake before use.
- Twist off the top of the single-dose container.
- Tilt your head back.
- Gently pull down your lower eyelid and look up.
- Hold the single-dose container above the eye and gently squeeze 1 drop in the eye and blink several times.
- Do not touch the eye or eyelashes with the tip of the single-dose container.

Single use.

The single-dose container must be used immediately after opening and disposed of after use.

Using a previously opened single-dose container may expose the eye to a risk of infection.

4. What are the possible side effects

Cationorm® is generally well tolerated. In very rare cases, a short term discomfort such as: eye irritation, eye pain, feeling like there is something in your eye, eye redness, eye itching, watery eyes, burning sensation in the eye, temporary impaired vision, eyelids inflammation or fluid retention in the eyelids can occur. However, these symptoms are common in dry eye disease and might be related to the underlying condition.

IF YOU NOTICE ANY SIDE EFFECTS THAT ARE NOT LISTED IN THIS LEAFLET, PLEASE INFORM YOUR DOCTOR, PHARMACIST OR OPTOMETRIST.

5. How to store Cationorm®

Store the single-dose containers in their outer box, below 30°C.

Keep out of the reach of children.

Do not use if the single-dose containers are damaged.

Do not use after the expiry date printed on the box.

Any opened individual single-dose container with any remaining emulsion should be discarded immediately after use.

Cationorm® contains: mineral oils, glycerol, tyloxapol, poloxamer 188, tris-hydrochloride, tromethamine, cetalkonium chloride (as cationic agent) and water for injections.

Each single-dose container of Cationorm® contains 0.4 ml of sterile emulsion.
